- Creating a legislated alternative to mandatory residential fire sprinkler code adoption for the state and local jurisdictions. This is an overwhelming victory – no one can adopt mandatory residential fire sprinkler code until 2012 and now there is an alternative ordinance model for adopting a mandatory offer of fire sprinklers rather than mandatory installation.
- Successfully supporting and partnering on an initiative to elect pro-economic development candidates to Springfield City Council, three of whom were elected in April 2009.
- Successfully defeating mandates at the state and local level including impact fees, mandatory warranties and other costly, unnecessary regulations.
- Advocating for pro-housing legislation, such as the Right to Repair legislation which passed in 2005 and has proven to reduce liability insurance premiums in the state.

Please read tournament rules below. These rules will be interpreted by the Tournament Committee and Ozark Shooters staff. All decisions final.

1. Shoot management may alter, change or add to the program if necessary as needed. Any changes or alteration to the program will be posted prior to each event.
2. Due to insurance liability, no one under the age of 18 will be allowed to rent or operate a golf cart on the premises.
3. NO alcohol allowed.
4. Eye and ear protection required.
5. Shoot management reserves the right to refuse any registration.
6. Ties will be determined by the station totals at preselected stations.
7. Contestants and spectators assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the grounds of the Ozark Shooters Sports Complex.
8. Ammunition not to exceed 2-3/4, 3-1/4 dr. eq., 7-1/2 shot.
9. Guns with open chokes recommended.
