NOTES AND LEGEND

- Denotes fence lines found on this survey.
- Denotes 3/4 inch steel reinforcing rods tagged L.S.2902 and set on this survey.
- Denotes 4 inch iron pipe fence corner posts found on this survey marking the corners of the Jewish Cemetery lot.

The meridian of this survey is identical with the meridian of that certain official map entitled "PLAT OF JACKSON GRAMMAR SCHOOL LAND", recorded in the office of the Recorder of Amador County on May 12, 1948, in Book 4 of Maps and Plats at page 46.

It is the recommendation of this surveyor that Boundary Line Agreements be entered into with all adjacent owners where a fence line forms the common boundary line, since these fence lines may or may not be coincidental with the original lot lines.
