Report on Trip to Eastern Europe in April.

I visited Graz for 5 days and on 22nd April was scheduled to speak in Osijek in Croatia where I had spoken nearly eight years earlier. The roads had changed a lot and since I was there the church had built a new Bible School! That night I spoke in the "Synagogue". Believers from different backgrounds were touched as I spoke about 'Living in His Presence' and 'Relying on the Holy Spirit as Our Teacher'. The message included 'Feeling the Grieving Witness of the Holy Spirit when You are Sinning'! The people thanked me afterwards. The message was recorded and streamed live to many other groups as well. The pastor (also the rector at the Bible School) was happy with the message and was also able to give some contacts to help get the book printed in Croatian.

The next day I travelled to Serbia by bus. I had one bag weighing over 40kg. (Both wheels were destroyed the first time I tried to use it in Croatia!) It was so heavy I had to leave it in the back of the Pastor's car when I arrived in Croatia! It contained books for Romania and I had to take them on the bus to Belgrade where I was to be picked up in a car. At immigration they asked about my luggage and I told them that they were Christian books. The man seemed to agree and said "Good," and let me enter with no trouble. The bag was left overnight in the car. After we arrived I saw children playing happily in the yard as some of the older children were washing the car. I spoke in a Gypsy church in Belgrade and the pastor arranged a translator. The translator mentioned that he did not know if he could be available on the Thursday evening but by God's grace he was! The message was 'Where are You Living' and 'Are You Producing the Fruits of the Spirit or the Fruits of the Flesh?' The people said it was a good message. They were hoping to buy books in their own language but I only had English copies.

From Belgrade I travelled to Romania by train but went to the wrong station. I still had the 40kg bag with me so there was no way I could walk. It took me nearly 15 minutes by Taxi. I had enough time as the Lord had told me to leave early but I had no local currency. The taxi drivers were very happy to see a visitor but they did not overcharge me. Even though I offered 10 Euros the taxi driver gave me 2 Euros back! I was also able to pay for all my train tickets in Euros which made it just a little more expensive. I reached the first station but the pastor did not come to meet me. When I called him he was not there and I was told to use a taxi. I could hardly lift my bags to get to the front of the station. The pastor had arranged for me to stay in the church and I had to carry the 40kg suitcase inside the church. The pastor could not take me to the seminar the next day either. On the Friday evening I spoke at a small gathering of about 10, where I had been before, and the people listened very carefully. The message touched them and afterwards 4 people bought books. Even the pastor was surprised at the way the people responded.

The following morning the leader of the Brethren church came early to collect me. Fortunately, I had all my bags ready. It took two people to lift the suitcase into the back of the car! The messages I shared were 'Two Ways to God' and 'How to get to Know Him by Grace Through Faith'. The leaders were very blessed by the teaching and asked me when I could return. They were happy to buy several copies of the book for their congregation who could not afford it. I was also able to speak to the translator in Timisoara and he was willing to translate the book, 'Wake Up Time is Running Out'. Afterwards the translator and the leader helped carry my bag to the train going to Satu Mare where I was able to leave all the books!

On Sunday morning there was a last minute change as my host in Satu Mare had to preach in the church in Baia Mare where I was to speak in the evening. Now I was included in the morning programme. There was already one speaker scheduled and I was given about 30 minutes. The main pastor was away but the assistant pastor was present and he was the one who hosted me last time. He was delighted to see me but had been expecting me in the evening. Afterwards many people purchased a copy of the book, 'My

Sheep Hear My Voice'. The church could seat about 1000 people and it was 70% full in the morning. In the afternoon I was invited to speak at a Young People's event and this was well attended too. Afterwards many people gathered around the table and thanked me for the message. Many young people came because they have to attend church in Romania but I saw many were touched by the message I shared. The Pastor's daughter translated for the first time so I had to go slowly and this seemed to help as people were listening very carefully to the words she used as well in case of a miss-translation.

I was able to find a direct train from Satu Mare to Debrecen, a town just inside Hungary. I had enough local currency for this and between trains in Debrecen, I had just enough time to buy a ticket before my next train. I arrived in Ujuszacs and, that night, spoke in the Lutheran church. The pastor could not host me as he was busy working in local schools but gave me 90 minutes for the message and asked me to be available at the end to pray for people. The message was about 'True Repentance' and those at the end, who came up to me, had genuine cases concerning forgiveness and true repentance! It was a great meeting and the pastor asked me to return for a seminar, if possible.

For my last meeting I travelled by train to Budapest and then through Slovakia to Brno in Bratislava. I used a local train from the small town, where I was staying, and then at the main station had to change my Hungarian Currency. Because I was rushing for my connection I did not get a good rate of exchange from a local person offering help! I did not acknowledge the Lord here! The last meeting in Brno was a Young People's meeting and I was able to get back to a church I had visited many years ago but was now meeting in a different venue. Afterwards some young people came and purchased the books in Czech and the assistant pastor was very thankful for the teaching. This was a great trip and on the way home I was able to fly directly from Prague to Luton airport. The Assistant pastor gave me an offering and also paid for my bus ticket to Prague Airport.

Report on Trip to Scandinavia in May 2015

In May I visited Denmark and Norway. I travelled on the day of the UK elections! I was blessed to speak in Svendborg and Thisted in Denmark and then on the way home I stopped over in Copenhagen. The church here was really touched by the message and said that they felt the message was clear. After the meeting in Svendborg there was an opportunity to travel by train early in the morning. One lady took me, by car, from the place where I was staying. I was able to help her with directions when she got to a place where she got lost in the town because her familiar road was closed. We were late leaving so we missed the train I had planned to get, but she was surprised by the fact that I could hear, "Turn around", "Turn left here", "Left again", "Turn right and straight on to get to the main station". There were no signs set up to re-direct the traffic! She asked me if I had been to the town before and I said "No!" She said "I am impressed."

After the meeting in Thisted, I had to travel early to get the train up to the ferry. There was no advice given about a bus to the ferry port in Hirtshals. Hirtshals was the final stop but that station was nearly two miles to the Ferry point I was going to use. However, the Lord directed me to the stop before Hirtshals and I could see that it was the closest to the Ferry terminal I was using. Although I had to walk with heavy bags and no wheels I arrived with plenty of time to spare! This reminded me of how the Ministry started. When I arrived at the ferry terminal I asked about a bus from Hirtshals but they said the shuttle bus was not operating that day. Every other day there was a regular bus from the last train stop but

Report on Trip to USA and Canada in June 2015

I was looking forward to this trip after my plans for the USA were postponed in March due to my eye operation in February. It felt like the trip was at least 4 months late but the people were prepared. The delay also allowed me to contact some churches in Canada and I was able to travel through Canada on the way to the West Coast of America. This was a trip that lasted eight days and covered the East and West extremities of North America.

I arrived in Newark (USA) on time and from there flew to Toronto. However, my connecting flight was nearly two hours late! Before I left the UK I had been waiting for a final confirmation on meetings in Harrisonville near Mississippi but, whilst in the airport, I learnt they had decided this was not the best time for them. The time in the airport gave me time to send out a prayer request and ask someone if they knew of another contact in the USA for a Monday and a Tuesday! (The churches in Dallas were not responding about a possible evening meeting on Monday.) The Lord directed me to send an email to one of the people I was meeting in Seattle. It was the husband of this person who recommended the Ministry and this eventually led to a meeting in De Ruyter in New York State. I was then able to confirm the new meetings and arrange the flight into Syracuse. Another lady pastor also wanted me to come and speak but I had to turn this down as my flights were arranged and I could not change.

The late flight connection in Newark meant I eventually met my host in Toronto Airport at 7pm instead of the planned 4pm. 7pm was also the time of the meeting but the people waited patiently for my arrival. When I arrived I sat down for a few minutes and was then asked to speak about 'Knowing Jesus Personally' for about 50 minutes. The people were blessed and the Pastor thanked me personally. This meeting was only possible because a Romanian brother picked me up at the airport and took me by car (one hour) to the location of the meeting. We arrived one hour after the meeting had started. At one stage, the meeting looked impossible as there had been a busy line of people at immigration in the Airport!

Eventually we drove back to Toronto arriving at midnight at the home of the Romanian brother and his wife. By the time I got to bed I had been awake for 24 hours! God gave me His grace and I was happy to take a rest. The next day I met a pastor from a Romanian church and spent the day seeing a little bit of downtown Toronto. The next morning I flew (two hours) to Winnipeg and I had only travelled half away across Canada! I was invited by Pastor Shevchuk, from Ukraine, who was the pastor of the Ukraine Evangelical Church in Winnipeg. I also met a Spanish speaking Pastor soon after I arrived at the airport. The next day, at the airport, I was checking my bags and was in the process of paying for the 20kg bag when there was a power outage and the process had to be completed manually. It meant that I did not have to pay the normal bag check-in fee! I flew to Vancouver and arranged to meet a lady between flights who was connected with one of our first mission trips in Europe. We had some time to catch up and she was keen to have an English copy of the book 'My Sheep Hear My Voice'. Then I got a flight from there to Seattle and entered the USA. This had been my first trip to Canada.

I spent two days (Friday and Saturday) in Seattle with the Pastor. There were three sessions altogether. I was able to speak on the subject of 'Trusting God with All Your Heart'. Someone asked "Do you really need to ask God everything?" I was able to answer this and all the other

questions and the people went home challenged. After the two sessions on Saturday there was time for more fellowship with Pastor Matthew and his family as I was staying in their home. Even late on the Saturday evening a Pastor came and, at a different time a couple as well, to ask more about the books. The feedback was that the message was very clear and convicting. According to the pastor, the message was resounding in the ears of everyone. One lady, who had planned some time just on her own with God, came to the meeting instead when she was touched by the Holy Spirit as she was passing by. She said the Lord reminded her of the meeting through a text message and she felt a heaviness to come as she was passing the church on the Saturday afternoon!

On Sunday morning, I left very early and flew to Sacramento to speak at a Chinese Church. The Pastor was happy to host me, as he also knew Pastor Mathew. One sister in the congregation, after hearing the message, gave me a long list of Chinese churches to contact regarding another visit to that area! She was very excited by the message and wanted me to come back. I actually arrived after the service had started in Sacramento and the pastor was already explaining how we all have to deny ourselves and obey God! The people were very open to the spirit-led life and seemed to realise from the message how to walk in the Spirit practically and deal with the carnal nature. Afterwards, many wanted the book in English rather than Chinese and at the end of the meeting I ran out of all available copies. For those who wanted the books I was able to order for them on line from our American office in Tulsa. The church had lunch outside where it was quite hot. I sat with the pastor in his air-conditioned office and spent some time with him. Afterwards there was not enough food left for a second plate! It was very delicious!

Immediately after eating I had to catch my flight to Los Angeles with South-West Airlines but the flight was delayed. When I arrived in LA my host, coming to collect me, did not bring his phone with him. He went into the baggage hall as I was coming out and we missed each other! I nearly asked him his name as I passed him. He had lost his phone while in the house as it had slipped down the side of the sofa! This was an extra delay but eventually we met up in the airport and this did not hinder the message. People came prepared as they had previously heard Yolanda Radillo. They received a clear message and everyone was blessed by the testimony. Afterwards the people bought copies of the books! Fortunately Yolanda who already had visited Los Angeles left some copies of 'My Sheep Hear My Voice' in February (2015).

I had only two hours sleep after the meeting in Los Angeles and then flew from Los Angeles to Dallas. In Dallas I had arranged to meet Kimberley Kok at the airport I was to pick up two boxes of the book 'My Sheep Hear My Voice' and one box of 'The Manifested Sons of God'. Time was very limited because I also needed a charger for my notebook computer with an American power socket. To make things even more challenging Kim came to the airport one hour late after getting stuck in some local traffic. I also needed to meet someone else and get back to the airport early and re-arrange my bags to carry an extra 30kg before travelling to Syracuse.

In Dallas, I checked one bag of 25kg . There was a fee of \$25. My hand carry was overweight (17kg) but they did not weigh this! They allowed me to check in this bag at the gate. My coat was also filled with extra items and books that I could not fit into any of my bags and one extra laptop size bag. While on board the next flight I was able to empty my coat into another bag with my personal items as well and at my connecting airport I checked my last bag and kept my lap top size bag. I was able to travel with nearly 50kg in total! Normally you are only allowed 23kg. In Syracuse I arrived late in the evening but the Pastor was happy to see me. We had some time to ask questions beforehand and do some sight-seeing the next day. He enjoyed asking questions and realised that he was getting many answers in a short time. He was touched by the message in the evening and many people also brought copies of all the books. I had planned to take more books back home but many were purchased instead! The people who came were also excited to hear from a British preacher!

I enjoyed stories from the region where some great evangelists had gone before and which gave me a great sense of excitement and awe. This region of New York State was filled with green valleys similar to Ireland and Wales and I really enjoyed every moment. The people were excited and shared how Charles Finney had reached the area in 1800, from New York, and that in many villages all were led to a personal knowledge of the Saviour. Those led to Christ in this region had a deep fear of God, an

awareness of sin and a full understanding of the Lordship of Jesus. I noticed the people gladly received the message of intimacy with God. My last meeting on this trip was the next day in New York itself. I arrived early at New York JFK airport and met a Pastor. He arrived late but then travelled with me by bus to Manhattan where I spoke at the UN. I had to walk one block on my own and this took 40 minutes because my bags were heavy. Fortunately, it was not raining but because of this it was hot and I had to keep stopping in the shade between the tall buildings. The sweat was pouring from my head.

At the UN I arrived early in order to complete the security arrangements. In the meeting many responded and got signed copies of their books. I had 20 minutes and it seemed some were not so open. Immediately after the meeting I had to travel back to get a bus to the airport. Due to traffic it took me nearly 40 minutes in a taxi to travel a distance that I walked on foot before. My bags were quite heavy. In the bus from Manhattan to the airport I had some time to eat and to re-arrange my baggage to keep within my check-in weight allowance. The flight home was a direct over-night flight to Birmingham. This was a very effective trip and afterwards, meetings were already being arranged for follow up visits.

Report on Trip to East Africa, June and July 2015

In June and July I normally travel to East Africa and on this trip I reached out to four countries. I also visited Cameroon. I had to get the bus from Nottingham and, with heavy luggage, get out at Golders Green bus stop because it is a long walk from London Victoria to the Underground station. I travelled with two large bags each of 23kg. One of the handles broke on the way to the airport from the weight of books. I flew, with Kenya Airways, to Nairobi which is 7 to 8 hours from London. I arrived in Nairobi in the early hours of Sunday morning. The Pastor came to pick me up and I thought he would take me straight to the place where I was supposed to speak. However, I had a short opportunity to get breakfast, change, wash and get books ready before I ministered to his people. This was a great help because I was to speak three times that day! The first meeting was a rural church meeting in a slum. They were very excited to hear someone all the way from the UK. I spoke there in the morning at 10 o'clock completing two sessions. The first session was with the congregation and the second with leaders. Immediately after the second service the pastor from the evening program came to pick me up at about 3 o'clock. However, he was running late so that when we eventually got to the service, around 4 o'clock, I only preached for about one hour. Then someone else came to pick me up to take me to the next meeting which started at 6pm. I finally got to rest that night about midnight. I stayed with the Pastor of the second church meeting. I was very tired but God gave me His grace and strength to speak at all three meetings. On Monday I travelled early to reach Compassion offices in Kenya because of the potential traffic in Nairobi. This was a meeting of many pastors from Kenya but the venue was far from the city. It took nearly an hour to get there even though there was not too much traffic. I arrived one minute before the service and the leader did not think I was arriving late! At the end of the service many asked about the books and wanted to buy several copies. Some had heard me last year and were very open to the message. As soon as the service finished I had some time with the leader of Compassion in Kenya and we discussed a date for next year, to speak to the group again. My visit this time was very special meeting because this was one of the few times when all the Pastors from that region of North, East, South and West Kenya are present due to the fact that it is the end of the accounting period!

After the meeting in Compassion I took a taxi directly to the airport. I had just enough time to reach the airport, exchange some Kenya Shillings and catch my domestic flight to Kisumu. My bags were well

overweight but somehow I managed to repack my bags and was not charged. They did not even weigh my hand luggage! My flight arrived in Kisumu and from there I was to take a trip by road. As I stood at the road side near the airport, I watched two buses pass, both of them bound for Kampala. One was a Kampala Coach and the other was an Easy Coach and they do not stop to pick up passengers along the way! These buses would have left at 6am from Nairobi. I even put up my hand to wave them down but neither of them stopped.

When I reached Kisumu I was met by two pastors and a prison Chaplin. They wanted to meet me and one of them travelled with me to Kampala. They helped me choose the correct public transport at the road side outside the airport! This was a small Nissan van stopping as it went to pick up and drop off other passengers. From the airport it was 3½ hours to the border. I had to cross by foot and this involved another 30 minutes filling out forms. The Pastor I met at the airport, who agreed to travel with me, helped carry my bags as well. I was grateful for his help. The temperature was 28° Celsius and quite humid. When I arrived in Kisumu airport there was a slight breeze blowing which made the heat manageable. I finally reach my destination in Kampala at 11 o'clock at night, this was 1½ hours later than I estimated. This was due to delays at the border and a further delay on the Ugandan side of the border waiting for the vehicle to fill up with passengers before leaving. The people waiting for me in Kampala were very relieved to see me. The driver from Compassion had been waiting since 9 o'clock, over 2 hours, for me to arrive at the petrol station along the main road. He waited faithfully with very little communication. The driver then took me to the hotel where I spent the night. There was no air-conditioning in the hotel but I did have a fan and that kept the temperature reasonable. I was also able to have a shower.

The next morning, Tuesday, I had to be up at 6 o'clock as Compassion Uganda had invited me to speak for 90 minutes on each of four mornings starting at 8am. All the staff had agreed to a period of fasting and seeking God during my visit but let me take breakfast every morning! Even those staying in the hotel were not taking breakfast. Compassion Uganda had heard about me through a very good recommendation from Compassion Kenya after I spoke there two years ago. Each message was around the subject of 'Wake Up Time is Running Out'.

Each day for the next 4 days in Uganda, I had 3 or 4 meetings. On Tuesday, after the morning meeting with Compassion, many people were excited about the teaching and after the program I left some books for them to buy. I then travelled to the UN in Entebbe. The whole time I was in Uganda Margaret Laloyo assisted me. She saw many people receiving the message and eyes being opened. On Tuesday evening we met in another church. This was called Springs of Life in Entebbe and finally at 6-7pm I was free to travel back to the hotel.

It was a blessing to have the use of the hotel in Uganda. This was offered because some of the staff for Compassion Uganda were also staying there. Every evening we had meetings and when I reached the hotel I was able to shower and get a good rest. There was also a net for keeping the mosquitoes away! When in Uganda I had never had anything like this facility and it made the trip more manageable. Margaret had brought her car all the way from the Northern part of Uganda to help with transport and make it easier for us to move around in Kampala. She had to drive 5 hours just to meet me when I arrived from Kenya. Fortunately the Hotel was not located too far from her rented house in Kampala.

On the Wednesday we had 4 meetings. The first was in Compassion again. The staff in the car were still excited and asking questions as we went to the meeting. I also spoke to leaders in the Anglican Church of Uganda. Previously I had spoken to those responsible for Sunday school and children's meetings. At the end of the meeting one vicar stood up and said "I have been really touched and edified by the message we heard today." Everybody said amen and thanked me. He wanted to know when I would visit his church! At lunchtime I spoke at the Bank of Uganda to the staff who wanted to attend. They specially requested that I bring more of the 'Hedgecock' books, because people were so blessed by the message the last time. I was surprised because I thought many already had the books but there was a real hunger in this meeting. In the evening I spoke in a rural church.

On Thursday I started again at Compassion. The second session was at the UN again and I then spoke in two other churches in the evening. The last meeting on Friday was in Entebbe again at the Deliverance Church. The evening meeting was especially

good where I was able to speak to leaders. This was arranged by one of the businessmen connected with the Deliverance Church in Entebbe. This businessman was also my host in 2014.

On Friday morning the program reached a critical point. Many in Compassion had a lot of questions about the message. Some of them even typed the questions out! God answered all their questions. I had a longer time speaking as well which helped. One brother came running after me just as I was leaving and wanted to apologise to me as he had judged me to be careless in my words. He thanked me and asked me to forgive him. He realised from the truth that he heard, as the questions were answered clearly, proved to him that my motive was love even though the messages were hard. Compassion Uganda had covered the cost of my hotel and they still wanted to give me a donation for my time. Each individual was also invited to give at the end. I was not expecting such a generous contribution to my visit. After this meeting I spoke at the lunch hour in Entebbe Airport. Compassion Uganda sent a driver with the offering they had collected because I was leaving from the airport immediately after the last meeting in Entebbe. In the Lunch hour I spoke to the airport staff and several of them remembered me from last year so they were excited to hear me speak again. Finally, in the afternoon, I had a pastors' meeting. I did not return to the hotel that night but travelled overnight to Burundi with RwandAir.

I have travelled to Burundi many times without obtaining a visa beforehand. On this occasion, I was expecting to get the visa at the airport again, but with the troubles in country the law had changed. I had asked one pastor about getting the visa at the airport about a month before and was told it was possible get the visa on arrival. I made enquiries after the trip and they had changed the rules in March 2015 so that British people could no longer get a visa on arrival. I was unaware of this and so was not able to enter the country on this trip. This happened because I had relied on local information from a pastor, which was not verified. When I arrived at Entebbe airport in the evening they told me I could not travel to Burundi. Instead I agreed with the airline that they would allow me to travel to Kigali reaching there at 11 o'clock on Friday night.

When I arrived in Kigali I had not made any arrangements with anybody because I was expecting to be in Bujumbura. I called someone who worked in the radio station who I had met only last year. He came immediately to pick me. He could not drive his own car because of a problem with his eye. So he asked his friend to drive and collect me. He also hosted me for the few extra days I was there. I contacted some pastors and they were happy to let me speak at short notice and the man from the radio station took me to every meeting. Books, I could not carry, were put on a bus and sent by road and he took me to the bus station the next day so that I could collect them! He had said he was going to do this for me if I came again and he really kept his word. He was very excited for me to be in his home. This was a person who only heard me once and was very touched by the messages he heard on the radio. He had agreed to help me as much as he could even though he was to travel to Dubai after the weekend. I went with him and his family to the airport the day he travelled and was then able to stay with somebody else, according to the original program, for the next 3 days.

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday I was scheduled to speak, during the lunch hour, in one of the largest gatherings in the centre of the Kigali. Every day there were over 200 people present. These were mostly leaders and their congregations from many different churches. On the last day they changed the programme and I did not speak there as another evangelist was coming but I was still able to share with them a message about 'Trusting God With All Your Heart'. During the day and in the evening I spoke at other churches, the program there was very effective.

After Kigali, I travelled to Yaounde in Cameroon. The flight I booked from Kigali, went through Nairobi with Kenya Airways and on to Douala. It also stopped in Yaounde on the way. I needed to start my programme in Yaounde and was hoping to get out in Yaounde but Kenya Airways would not let me do this without a payment of more than \$400 to do so. Therefore I ended up arriving in Douala at around 11:30am (one hour late). First, I had to collect my bags but one of my bags, containing most of the books, had not arrived. I got my bag with clothes and a few books and then I had to proceed to get the bus and travel another five hours back to Yaounde. Francis, a friend of Dr Asomba my host in Cameroon, came to meet me at the airport. Francis also returned the next day to collect the late bag from Kenya Airways. He also collected some books coming from Nigeria by road. I was very blessed because the bag that came had all my clothes in it! The few books I had packed in this bag were also just enough to cover all the meetings I had in Yaounde. It proves that you need to ask God what to pack in each suitcase!

In Yaounde, one brother had set up a guesthouse as an NGO organisation and was hosting me for three days. He also took us to all the meetings by car. I was assisted by Sister Flora who is based in Yaounde and responsible for co-ordinating the meetings there. She also had a lot of questions, mostly about the culture of Cameroon and how so many people were not really trusting and relying on Christ on a daily basis and being led by the Spirit. They would rather confess their sins and use the name of Jesus to command the devil to go away. Many West Africans shout using the name of Jesus to try and make their lives on earth more blessed. They do not use the time given by the grace of God for repentance. Jesus is coming soon and many will not be ready. Flora explained how those receiving Christ in Cameroon often swapped their own false gods for the Name of Jesus Christ to invoke blessings rather than live a holy life. I spoke in Yaounde Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

On Monday we proceeded to a place called Limbe in the South West part of Cameroon, where I spoke to a large gathering. Sister Flora also travelled with me there assisting me up until the last day. We had to leave Yaounde at 5am so we would not be late for the meeting. This bus journey, to Douala, took more than seven hours with stops along the way. In Douala, Francis was there waiting with the books and my bag that had arrived on the later flight. Then we used public transport again and arrived about 4 o'clock in the afternoon in Limbe. I got some rest that night and next morning travelled back to Douala.

On the Tuesday night I was scheduled to speak in a small church. This was the church Francis was attending. Francis had spoken to his Pastor about me and about the message. He had read a copy of the book, 'My Sheep Hear My Voice' while I was in Yaounde after they arrived from Cameroon from Nigeria. He was very excited about the message and said "These are good books"!! Francis had collected the books from Kenya Airways, and the books from Nigeria, on his personal motor cycle!

Flora and I travelled by car from Limbe to Douala and then had to get a taxi to the part of Douala where Francis lived. Throughout the time I was in Douala this brother used his one motorcycle. Sister Flora and I both went on the back of the motor

cycle with a small bag of books in front! He had to weave through long lines of traffic because of congestion and many hold ups on the way to and from the church even as late as 9pm. A few came prepared to buy books. After the service, some people asked questions and wanted to come and hear me again, but I said I was leaving to go back to the UK. However, I was able to introduce them to Flora so that they had a contact there. I had two bags to carry back with me to London. Both weighed about 23kg. I travelled back with as many books as I had left with! The books I took back with were printed in Nigeria and get used throughout Africa. This was an opportunity to restock the UK reserves as I need the books for other parts of Africa.

I stayed with Francis in his home and slept in the children's bedroom. He had four children! Francis also gave us food. Flora slept on the sofa in his front room with the children and left in the morning at 5am. He took her to the bus stop on his motorcycle. To get to the airport was an African experience! He put one bag in front of him, one bag behind me and I sat squashed in the middle on his motorcycle with these two large bags. We arrived safely despite some problems with heavy traffic along the way. Even with these bags he was able to weave in between the traffic! Using a motorcycle has benefits when there is a lot of traffic and we arrived in enough time. I was able to change the last bit of money I had back into US Dollars and board the flight back to London. This was a blessed trip. I had covered five countries and had about 25 meetings in East Africa and 8 in Cameroon.

Testimony

As promised, here is a little update on what the Lord has been doing since your visit. I found that your visit was a divine wake up from the Lord. The whole time you were here, He kept touching my heart with the love of God as if to say, "This is the way. Set everything else aside. If you really want to know Me, this is truly the way."

Thank you so, so much for flying the miles and coming! The Lord has shifted and changed many things in my life since your visit. Some of what He did might not make a lot of sense without some understanding of my background. So here is a brief little bit of my story:

As a little girl, my heart was tender towards Jesus. I had a children's Bible and would read it and talk to God. I remember playing a game with some girls on the playground in 4th or 5th grade. We whispered the name of our best friend into each other's ears. I whispered, "God." However, due to things that happened growing up, I ended up getting angry at Jesus and my sinful reactions towards my parents and others separated me from Him and others. Rejection and unloved took root. I spent a lot of time hiding away in my room. Inwardly, I went into all kinds of sin and rebellion, including dabbling in the occult.

In college, I went into the new age, hungry for God and a connection with the spiritual. For the next thirteen years, I looked for God, trying many things in the new age and even in many countries in Asia. God was faithful to warn me or even block me many times!

Then, when nothing in the new age had worked and I was at the lowest point in my life, and really a mess with demonic oppression, the Lord brought me back to Himself! He had been moving in my life on many different fronts for several months. On one particular day, as I was about to go for a jog at a wooded nature trail called the Watershed (which means, "turning point"), He said to me, "As you're jogging, thank Me for being near." I had always thought of Him as being distant. So, as I was jogging, I kept thanking Him for being near. Each time I did that I felt joy.

When I was done jogging, I was standing and looking at some trees when suddenly, His presence surrounded me. It felt like total love and acceptance. It was so restful, like I didn't have to do a thing to fix myself. (I was always trying to fix myself with "self-help" because I was so messed up.) He just loved me. His presence was incredibly peaceful. I didn't remember ever feeling peace like that. He just washed over me with total love. Even though I was at the height of sin at that point, He didn't come down hard on me. Suddenly, I knew that I knew that Jesus was the way, the truth, and the life. I knew that Christianity was real and true. I knelt down and repented of idolatry and gave my life 100% to the Lord. Someone had told me that there was a throne in my heart, so I asked Jesus to sit on that throne.

I was so happy to be able to know Jesus at last that it was full steam ahead to knowing Him! I didn't experience the "honeymoon period" that others have described. It was a battle against the forces of darkness for about nine months to get free of all that I had engaged in when in the new age. Once I learned about specifically renouncing and confessing my sin related to other religions and the occult, it was much better.

Just after your visit, the Lord highlighted key areas of sin that He wanted to work on. After confessing my sin, I sat with the Holy Spirit, and He brought to my remembrance something you said in the message about a time when you ignored the grieving of the Spirit. I asked Him to show me if I had done that. He brought up different events where I ignored or overrode His warnings, and He led in repentance over that. Most of those times were when I was away from the Lord in the new age. He tried to warn me to protect me from a serious sin. Many of those times I didn't realize it was Him, but it was still a sin against the Holy Spirit. When I went back to listen to the message you gave, I was amazed to hear you speak about that because I didn't remember all the details of what you said but it was the same thing the Holy Spirit was saying. I cried out to the Holy Spirit for several days to forgive me for any time I had grieved Him, quenched Him, vexed Him, and hardened my heart against Him! I kept asking Him to soften my heart and to heal my conscience.

The Lord took me back to my childhood and led in confession of sins - leaving my first love Jesus, forgiveness, judgments, rebellion, hardening my heart against His will, anger, self-hatred, etc etc. I've gone through this before but it was at a deeper level. It looked like He was showing me that I may have been saved as a young child. He was certainly holding me accountable for all the years since then and not just the time after He brought me back to Himself.

Just trying to do what you said as far as getting into His presence and staying there was like a rubber meets the road experience. I confessed and confessed according to 1 John 1:9, but I couldn't really tell if I was in His presence. It felt peaceful, but it didn't seem to change, so maybe I wasn't in His presence. Then something very painful happened, and I really struggled with condemnation. The blessing of that was that then I knew for sure that I wasn't in His presence!

So, I wasn't able to get into His presence but didn't know why. I asked the Lord to expose and eliminate the hindrances. This may have been the Holy Spirit leading. I felt to read the book of Romans from the beginning. As I read chapters 1 and 2, I just felt this weight of sin and conviction. I was the very thing that Paul wrote about! I could feel the weight of sin on me since I was a child. The song, "At the Cross," came to me, and as I sang it, I started crying. He led me in repentance for having left Him, in childhood, as my first love, anger towards Him as a child for things that happened, leaving Him and going into the world and new age, and judging Him that He was silent and didn't help me in a time of need. It was like He took me back to the time of childhood and the teen years and was dealing with that time period. There were many tears, repentance, and confession. I gave up control, surrendered all to Him, and opened up my heart. My mind seemed to be in control so I surrendered it to Him. I saw that I was a Jacob - a swindler, deceiver, and a liar. I had broken the commandments. I was a sinner. I cried out for His forgiveness and opened my heart and made myself totally vulnerable to Him.

Still, it didn't seem that I was able to get into His presence! The next day, I went back to Romans 1 and 2. Again, as I read it, a deep conviction came. It was like coming to grips with who I was, since a child. The Lord showed that I had hardened my heart against my parents when they had disciplined me as a child. Rather than admit that I did anything wrong, I hardened my heart against them (and God) each time. I confessed this as a sin against the Holy Spirit.

I felt a deep conviction over those childhood years. Confession of those sins was largely by going down the list of the 10 commandments. Again, I saw that I was a Jacob. He showed me my true condition and the utter depravity of the sin nature. I felt so wicked. On the flip side, I saw good works that were all worth nothing. There was self-righteousness and pride. Keith, I could even hear the Holy Spirit bringing to my remembrance something you said in your message, "You're not righteous." It wasn't condemning, though - just the truth. Both the good and bad were all evil. The whole root was evil. I didn't know how He could possibly forgive me!

Then He put the thought in my mind that He saw the worst thing about me, and He took it on the cross. He also reminded me that at age 32, He was the one who brought me back to Himself. He alone did it, with no one else around, to let me know that, even at the height of my sin, He still loved me. He had not rejected me. In fact, He showered nothing but total love and acceptance upon me.

Then I saw something like darkness with snakes, and someone with a choice to come into the light or go back into the darkness. It felt like this was at the time of when I was a child or early teen. I didn't know how He could forgive me, but I didn't want to be in that darkness, so I desperately confessed whatever came to mind. There was a wrestling going on to receive His forgiveness. The Lord brought to mind something you had written to me, "You're judging yourself." I forgave myself for having turned my back on Him as a child. I felt so bad and so wicked. Again, the thought came that He saw the worst thing about me and took it on the cross. I confessed my true sinful condition and cried out for His forgiveness.

Then my heart felt different. It felt soft instead of dull. I could feel the love of God on my heart. The condemnation was gone. I could feel His peace, joy, and rest in my heart. It feels like I just got saved, Finney style! I don't really understand yet what He did, but it sure does feel like a honeymoon now! That was a couple of weeks ago. It has stayed with me except for when I do something that causes me to lose His peace and then I have to confess my sin to get back in.

Am working through *Wake Up* and letting the Holy Spirit lead through the notebook in what He would like to work on. I was able to order a copy of last year's 2014 SOLM Biannual Conference mp3s and am listening to them. What a blessing. They are helping me to understand how to approach *Wake Up*. The Youtube video of you speaking in the Philippines, "Love Relationship with God," also encouraged me very much.

Praise and thanks to the Lord Jesus Christ! Thanks again for your visit. I'm so thankful for the truth that you and Joseph have brought, and for someone that can help to show me the way to know Him. The Lord bless you!

We hope and pray that as you have read the above reports and testimony that you have been sensitive to the Spirit and have been blessed by asking Him if any of the experiences described could apply to you. This process, of being sensitive to His promptings, through the experiences and testimony of others, is something He uses to help you discover areas that He wants to remove from you. This is so that your relationship with Him can develop to a higher level and your life be one of greater testimony to the goodness and greatness of God.
